Is your firm on OASIS+? [GSA has released an RFI](#) to explore adding additional domains to the OASIS+ contracts. The RFI closes 5:00 PM EST on Tuesday July 8, 2025. **Our strong recommendation is for everyone to respond to the RFI so that GSA receives much constructive feedback to help shape the vehicle.** The RFI is asking questions about Phase II domains AND on-ramp for Phase I domains from 2023.

If you are planning on work with DHS this coming quarter, make plans for possible procurement delays. As agency acquisition offices gear up for their peak season, the Department of Homeland Security is adding another level of scrutiny to its procurement processes. [DHS Secretary Kristi Noem is requiring her office to review and sign off on all contracts and awards over \\$100,000.](#) The claim is that each review will take no more than five days, but some speculate on whether that will be reasonable to achieve. Plan accordingly.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) is preparing to recompete the C2AIS opportunity to support Command and Control (C2) systems integration aboard cutters and in development labs. The requirement spans engineering support—software, hardware, test, network, and electronic—as well as technical writing and integration services for SeaWatch and SeaCommander platforms. This opportunity supports C4IT modernization in maritime environments and represents a substantial recompete with small business preferences. USCG plans to award a follow-on to continue seamless support of afloat mission systems critical to national security and maritime operations.

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SECOND, FY25 Enterprise Platforms Management Support (EPM Support)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The FY25 Enterprise Platforms Management Support contract will continue critical services for DHS Software Development Division (SDD) programs. It supports enterprise-level platforms including SaaS, databases, cloud applications, and Windows environments. This opportunity emphasizes architectural planning, development, O&M, and agile methods to enhance the intranet portal and core systems. With a projected value between \$10M and \$20M, this recompete represents a significant opportunity to shape the future of DHS's digital infrastructure.

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THIRD, US MARINE CORPS RECRUITING COMMAND NETWORK SUPPORT SERVICES (RCEN NSS)

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Marine Corps Recruiting Command (MCRC) seeks continued Network Support Services (NSS) for the Recruiting Command Enterprise Network (RCEN), supporting over 6,000 users across 1,500+ CONUS and OCONUS sites. This requirement includes enterprise help desk, cybersecurity, infrastructure modernization, cloud migration, and support for critical systems like MCRISS.

This opportunity reflects a strategic shift to hybrid cloud, zero trust architecture, and data center optimization, advancing mission agility and compliance with DoD cyber mandates.

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FOURTH, PROJECT MANAGER SUPPORT SERVICES FOR DEFENSIVE CYBER OPERATIONS (PMSS – DCO)
